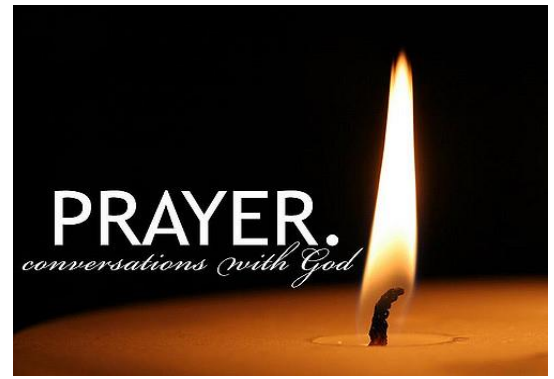


Prayers for the Circuit



Sunday

Pray for the life and witness of your own church. Find out what's happening throughout the week and reflect on your role in these activities. Pray that today's worship will bring people closer to God and to the ways of Christ.

Monday

Pray for the schools in your area. Find out their names. Does anyone from the circuit go into these schools? What do they do? Pray for them. Pray for teaching and non-teaching staff and pray for the pupils.

Tuesday

Pray for your wider community. Picture it: businesses, medical facilities, emergency services, residential homes, places of work, community groups volunteers and places for leisure activities.

Wednesday

You belong to the Christchurch and Wimborne Circuit. Pray for its staff and leaders. Pray week by week for church officers at different churches in the circuit. Pray they will know God's wisdom as they seek to give leadership.

Thursday

Pray for Revd David Hollingsworth as he develops a ministry of mission and outreach in markets and on streets, in schools and residential homes. Pray for people from the circuit to work with him so the work can continue when he leaves. Might it be you?

Friday

Pray for people in the news, often because of disaster, trauma and violence. Hold them in God's presence and hold on to the hope that the risen Jesus Christ brings. Pray for the Bus in the Square ministry in Wimborne tonight. Pray for Michelle Goddard who has left this circuit to train as a Deacon.

Saturday

The circuit prayer meetings are on the 2nd Saturday of the month at Colehill and Barton, 8.30 -9.00 am. Will you join us there in prayer? Pray for tomorrow's preachers and worship leaders. Pray for congregations to be ready to hear God's word and be enthused and encouraged.
