Wednesday 16th December 2020: The fourth Candle is lit for the Virgin Mary:

Candle 4: The Virgin Mary was the mother of God's Son, Jesus Christ! Because Mary was a good and faithful person, who trusted God completely and obeyed His commands, she was especially chosen by God. Reflection:
