Summary of the Christchurch and Wimborne Circuit Meeting held on Thursday 16th March 2023.

The meeting was chaired by Reverend Nicholas Wood with 35 members present and 9 apologies received.

Written reports covering Safeguarding, Local Preachers and Worship Leaders, Finance Reports and Property Report were accepted.

The appointed Circuit Stewards are Joyce Wild (Lead), Rodney Betts (Treasurer), Peter Aston, Shirley Hewitt and Christopher Slade. There is a vacancy for one further Circuit Steward.

Reverend Deborah Cornish, who was a Superintendent Minister at Brighton and Hove, was matched as a part time minister for Wimborne Methodist Church, starting in September 2023.

The Circuit Leadership Team (CLT) are actively pursuing solutions for Methodist Churches at Blandford and Colehill.

Methodist Women in Britain (MWiB): their project this year is looking at a partnership with a Romanian church in connection with an orphanage.
