Good news: The exciting news just keeps on coming. Firstly, on Thursday 16th March I was able to tell you about the Reverend Deborah Cornish who, through stationing, was matched with Wimborne and who will begin her role in September on a part time basis.

Secondly, Reverend Dr Mark Kimber, at present a minister without appointment, has agreed after consultations with Colehill and Blandford to be their minister from September for four sessions a week. These sessions will be shared equally between the two churches.

Thirdly, to assist the new superintendent Reverend Andrew Pottage, instead of the two lay persons posts we originally thought were needed we now have Reverend Peter McNeill, a supernumerary minister who, in a Team Ministry alongside the new superintendent on a part time basis, will have pastoral responsibility for Highcliffe and Mudeford Lane.

They say things come in threes and that is exactly what has happened. These posts will have no effect on the budget or assessments.
