It was a time for people wanting a more charismatic/contemporary expression of worship, to gather in prayer to seek God's presence in the town of Blandford. Part of the bible reading was to focus on John the Baptist, where his mission had been prophesied some seven hundred years earlier by Isaiah: "The voice of one crying in the wilderness, 'Make ready the way of the Lord, Make His paths straight'" (Matthew 3:3 https://biblia.com/bible/nasb95/Matt%203.3 ; cf. Isaiah 40:3-4 https://biblia.com/bible/nasb95/Isa%2040.3%E2%80%934). John was preparing the hearts of the Jews for the coming of their long-awaited King. To bring this up to date, the message on Sunday was that we need to be in our own places of wilderness, in other words getting out of our Churches, to meet people in Blandford and prepare the ground for the coming of our Lord.
