As Christians, it would be good if we committed ourselves to reading firstly Mark's Gospel with its sixteen chapters, followed by Psalms 15, 1, 8, 16, 23, 46, 63, 67, 100, 117, 150, 121, 133, 119 v 57-64. To add an extra dimension to the reading of the Psalms why not try learn one of them off by heart.

The daily Bible readings from Mark's Gospel help us focus on Jesus as we prepare for Good Friday and then Easter Sunday and knowing portions of scripture is always a blessing. So, there we have the taking something on board, but what about the giving something back, you might be asking. Well, for this connexional year as a church we have committed ourselves

to supporting two specific charities, Safe Families in Dorset and the Health Bus Trust. To do this fund raising is necessary. Might I suggest that alongside our weekly offering, we each donate £1.00 extra which is to be placed in a specially provided box that can be found on the table in the Narthex from Sunday 22nd. At the end of Lent the money collected will be added to other monies raised as our donation to the two charities.
